### From the Classroom to the Real World

Making the transition from the English language classroom to the English-speaking world is challenging for students and the gap between these two realities may seem wide. In this talk, we will explore classroom activities that narrow the gap and make students more 'real world ready'. We will also consider the importance of encouraging students to develop a 'real world' mindset which helps them to become English language learners not only inside but also outside the classroom.

**Denis Delaney** was born in Dublin, Ireland, where he graduated from University College Dublin with a degree in Linguistics. He taught English in Italy for almost twenty years and is now actively involved in teacher training. He and Philippa Bowen have written several best-selling language courses published by Oxford University Press and their new scuola media course *New Step Up* will be available in Italy in 2024.



### The Teacher Story and the Curiosity Factor

One thing that fascinates human beings is other human beings and it is the narratives and interaction between each other that enables us to learn and develop not only core language proficiencies, but also develop life skills, promote critical thinking and foster active citizenship. But in order to engage learners we first have to arouse their curiosity. Jamie is also an affiliate trainer at Norwich Institute for Language Education (NILE) in the UK.
